


2017-2018 Financials

The Stanley Clark School's net assets as of June 30, 2018 were approximately \$12.7 million, including an endowment of approximately \$5.1 million. As with most independent schools, tuition is the largest source of revenue and covers approximately 77% of the school's budget. The school relies on income from its endowment and the support of the greater SCS family through charitable giving for the amount not covered by tuition and other revenues. Every gift is a direct investment in our academic programming, our talented faculty members and our facility at The Stanley Clark School.

The Stanley Clark School is a 501 (c)(3) organization and is therefore exempt from federal and state taxes. A copy of the school's federal tax Form 990 is available upon request. The school has received an unqualified opinion on its financial statements from its independent auditors, Crowe, for the past 30 years.


